

Disaster – Survival Kit Checklist (Basic)

1. **Food and Water:**
 - a. Non-perishable food items
 - b. Manual can opener
 - c. Drinking water (1 gallon per person per day)
 - d. Cleaning water (for hygiene and cleaning)
 - e. Water purification tablets or a filter

2. **First Aid Kit:**
 - a. Adhesive bandages and sterile gauze
 - b. Antiseptic wipes and ointment
 - c. Tweezers and scissors
 - d. Thermometer
 - e. Pain relievers
 - f. Prescription medications (if needed)
 - g. First aid manual

3. **Communication:**
 - a. Battery-powered or hand-crank emergency radio
 - b. Extra batteries
 - c. Whistle or signaling device
 - d. Multi-tool or Swiss Army knife

4. **Lighting:**
 - a. Flashlights with extra batteries

- b. Candles and waterproof matches
- c. LED headlamp
- 5. **Clothing and Shelter:**
 - a. Warm clothing
 - b. Sturdy shoes or boots
 - c. Mylar blankets or sleeping bags
 - d. Tarp or emergency tent
- 6. **Personal Hygiene and Sanitation:**
 - a. Hand sanitizer
 - b. Wet wipes
 - c. Toothbrush and toothpaste
 - d. Feminine hygiene products
 - e. Trash bags
- 7. **Important Documents:**
 - a. Copies of identification
 - b. Insurance policies
 - c. Bank account information
 - d. Family contact list
 - e. Maps of the area
- 8. **Tools and Equipment:**
 - a. Duct tape
 - b. Multi-purpose tool
 - c. Rope or paracord

- d. Work gloves
 - e. Small shovel
 - f. Compass
 - g. Fire Starter
9. **Cash:**
- a. Small denominations of local currency
10. **Special Needs:**
- a. Baby supplies (if applicable)
 - b. Pet supplies
 - c. Medical equipment and supplies
11. **Entertainment:**
- a. Playing cards or small games
 - b. Paperback books or magazines
12. **Miscellaneous:**
- a. Notepad and pen
 - b. N95 respirator masks
 - c. Local area maps
 - d. Compass
13. **Emergency Plan:**
- a. Family emergency plan
 - b. Meeting point in case of separation
